Susan said that these quilts are given to children when they need a medical evaluation and the kids find them very comforting. In her 10 years with Child Advocacy Susan has seen over 1,000 victims.

Rene Crowder presented a program and trunk show on Scrappy Quilts. Her examples were all beautiful. So, the scrappy quilts turn out looking great, she suggested picking a theme or color. For example, for a particular quilt you might stick to Civil War prints or 30's pastels or brights. It gives a coherence to the overall look of the quilt. Great program!
